Action Items	Richard shared that there were three bidders for the Uniform/Linen service. TMTA formed a 6-member committee, and they met with each bidder individually.	MOTION: Rodd Miller moved, and Candis Stiles seconded to award the RFB 2-2505 UniFirst. Motion passed 5-0.	

Richard said that there were six bids for replacing the 200 Rodd Miller seconded to award the	
Crane maintenance facility building roof. Richard spoke with our architect, and his estimate was \$87,000 for this project. The project is in maintenance's budget, and we decided on a 30-year warranty. TMTA recommends Alpha Roofing, based in Lawence, Kansas. They were the lowest bidder at \$91,000.	
Richard updated the board regarding the grant status for the 2021 Lo-No grant from the FTA. TMTA made a budget revision in our grant for electric buses in February 2025. We removed the mention of "Proterra" from this grant due to their insolvency. The FTA approved the change on March 6, 2025. We have ordered four electric buses from Gillig.	
Richard recommended to the board that we make a change to the bank we use. Currently, we are working with US Bank. Their interest rates are not competitive. Richard said that they have not been responsive when we have questions or if there is an issue.	
Bob & Richard met with Silver Lake Bank. The advantages of working with them are the ICS account, and they will not charge service fees. The pros Richard highlighted were how they operate, flexibility, clearing and investment. They do not offer interest accounts. Richard asked if the board would like him to meet with other banks or would the board prefer to talk to Silver Lake Bank. The board said put it out for bid.
