- 1) Remove the existing coping, counterflashing and edge metal.
- 2) Tearoff flashing at wall, pipes and equipment curbs.
- 3) Make cuts to the existing EPDM rubber roof at every 10 foot.
- 4) Install ½" plywood blocking at the edge metal areas.
- 5) Fasten ½" HD Isocyanurate cover board over the existing roof.
- 6) Adhere Elevate 115 TPO fleece back membrane over the coverboard.
- 7) Adhere flashing at walls and equipment with 60 mil. TPO flashing.
- 8) Reinstall the existing coping and counterflashing.
- 9) Install new prefinished Metalera edge metal. (meets ES1 requirements)
- 10) Apply TPO flashing at edge metal.
- 11) Twenty year manufacturers warranty, 2" hail coverage
