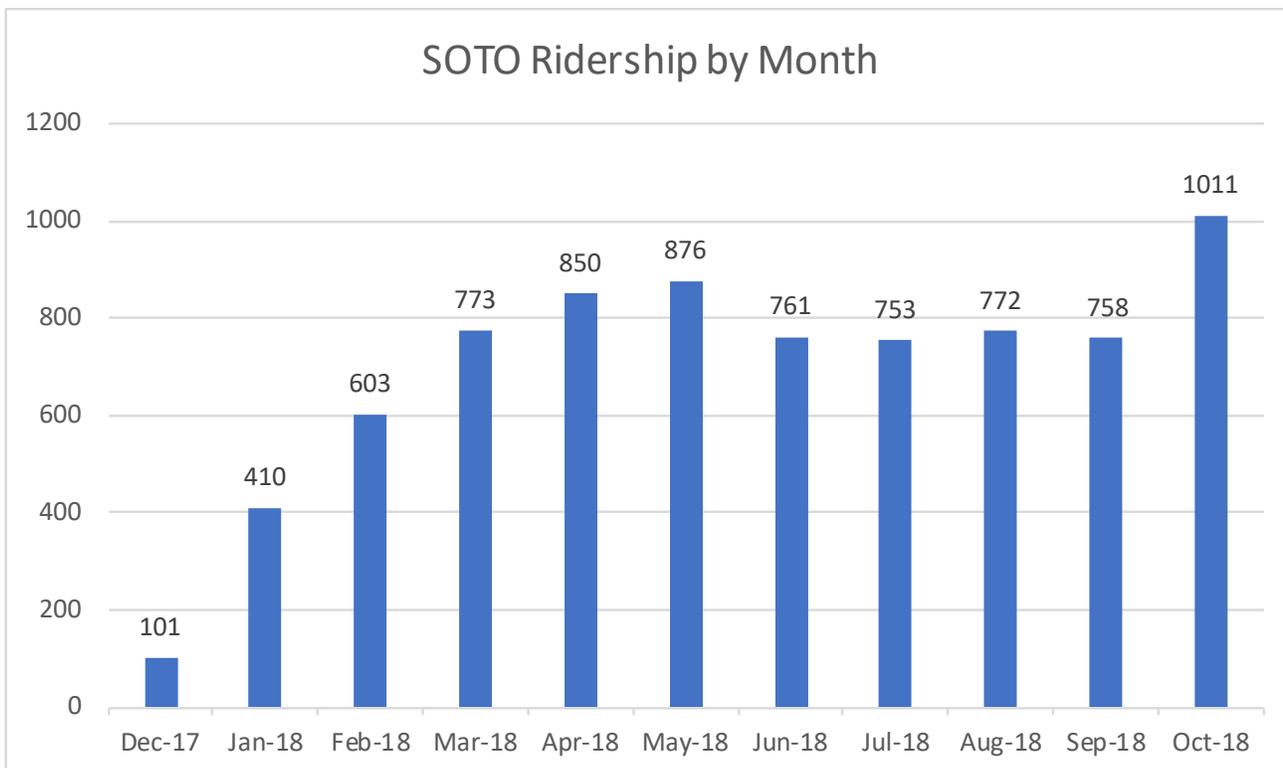

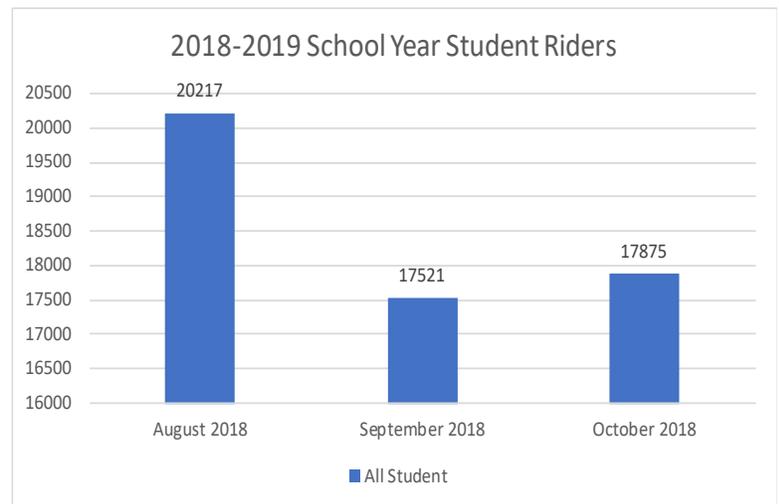
Ridership Table Notes

- Line 11: Year-to date Washburn ridership continues to lag FY 2017 levels by over 30%.
- Line 13: 74 Flex rides was the third highest number of rides ever (79 in November 2016, 76 in June 2016), 91% above the average of 39 monthly rides in the last 12 months.
- Lines 21-22: The number of Ambulatory Lift rides continues to fall. 61 rides is the lowest amount on record (since FY 2014) and 67% below the 12 month average of 186 rides monthly. The increase in the number of riders in wheelchairs offset the decrease in ambulatory passengers.
- Not shown- Year-todate FY 2019, total Paratransit ridership is up 18% (9,890 vs. 8,373).
