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## NATURAL GAS SALES PROPOSAL Topeka Metro Sept 8, 2020

Clearwater Enterprises, LLC is a full service, independently owned and regionally focused mid-continent energy company. Clearwater was founded in 1999 and currently serves more than 2,500 retail customers in multiple states.

### **SUPPLIER RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Clearwater Enterprises will purchase, nominate, balance and deliver natural gas to the KGS city gate for final delivery to facility.

#### TERM:

1, 2, or 3 years out of October 1, 2020 and year to year thereafter subject to a 45 day written notice of cancellation prior to the end of the initial term or any subsequent anniversary date.

**PRICING:** This pricing does NOT include the SSCGP transportation charges as requested. Topeka Metro will be responsible to contract with SSCGP their own transportation agreement. If one is not established, Clearwater will pass through and charge customer the maximum tariff transportation charges.

#### INDEX PRICE:

12, 24, or 36 month terms = The price for all base-load volumes shall be equal each month to The Monthly Index Price per MMBtu as reported for the first day of each month by Inside F.E.R.C.'s Gas Market Report: under the heading "Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline Texas, Oklahoma, and Kansas" plus \$0.20 per MMBtu plus pipeline fuel. As described in the Pricing Section above, SSCGP transportation charges NOT included therefore Topeka Metro must contract their own transport with SSCGP.

#### **INCREMENTAL PRICING:**

Swing Allowance is 0%.

To the extent that Buyers actual burn volumes vary from First of Month nominations, for all gas delivered in excess of the Nominated Volume, Seller has the option to charge Buyer Seller's cost for natural gas plus \$0.20/MMBtu plus SSCGP transportation and fuel charges. For unutilized volumes, Seller has the option to charge Buyer Seller's cost of gas less \$0.20 per MMBtu for unutilized volumes.

**CREDIT:** Approved with payment terms of Net 10 days to pay from the invoice date or 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, whichever is latest. ACH acceptable.

The contractor must promptly notify Metro, whenever a DBE subcontractor performing work related to this contract is terminated or fails to complete its work, and must make good faith efforts to engage another DBE subcontractor to perform at least the same amount of work. The contractor may not terminate any DBE subcontractor and perform that work through its own forces or those of an affiliate without prior written consent of Metro.
