RECOMMENDATION	Accept report.					
SUMMARY	There were zero accidents in September. Excellent! Beginning September 7 th , we stopped providing free disposable face masks to passengers. Passengers not wearing their own personal mask upon boarding the bus or entering a facility, were refused entry. Operators were directed to immediately report the incident and the supervisors would provide oversight and passenger instruction. None of these incidents have resulted in an altercation or TPD involvement. The bus shelter at 21 st & Potomac was vandalized on September 17 th . One glass panel was shot at and broken. The bus shelter and amenities at 21 st & Washington was hit by a vehicle and destroyed on September 29 th . Bus operator Ben Walton retired on September 20 th . He had been an operator with Metro for over seven years. His absence resulted in increased operator overtime beginning with the October 7 th pay period. Hiring bus operators continues to be an issue.
