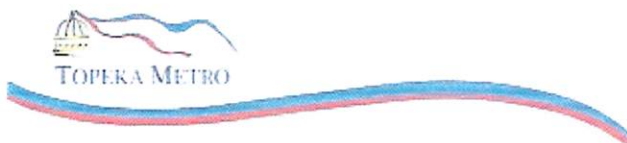


NON-COLLUSION CERTIFICATION

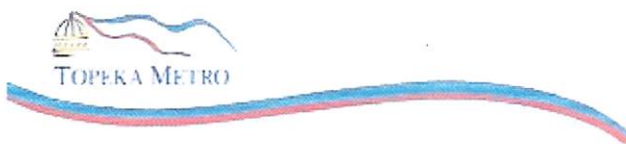
