RECOMMENDATION	Accept report as presented.					
SUMMARY	In April, key Operations personnel worked with the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) to perform an on-site Security Enhancement Through Assessment (SETA). This no-cost tactical assessment consists of TSA covertly placing unattended bags on multiple vehicles simultaneously to simulate a coordinated terrorist attack. The goal was to see how many of the operators did a proper vehicle pre-trip inspection, found the bags, and reported them. TSA agents were on-site prior to service on April 16 <sup>th</sup> to place ten (10) bags in random vehicles. Adam Alford with TSA then attended the Operations quarterly safety training on April 22 <sup>nd</sup> to report the good news that operators found all ten bags during their pre-trip inspections and to discuss the importance of proper vehicle inspections. TSA will return to do a secondary random assessment in the near future.					
	Topeka Metro supervisors, managers, and ATU #1360 members joined together for the annual Stuff the Bus campaign on April 19 <sup>th</sup> . It was held at Dillons at 21 <sup>st</sup> & Fairlawn from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The group raised 1,211 pounds of food and \$258 cash. Proceeds go to Project Topeka.
