RECOMMENDATION	Accept report as presented.
SUMMARY	There were zero chargeable accidents in February, which is excellent considering the bus operators experienced three snowstorms resulting in multiple days of hazardous road conditions. During the month, two bus shelters were vandalized. Boarding refusals for passengers who refuse to wear a face mask on the bus continue to decrease. There were 118 such incidents in September, 83 in October, 77 in November, 44 in December, 35 in January, and 32 in February. FREEdom Pass ridership hit a mile marker! Over 50,000 FREEdom Pass trips have been provided on the fixed route since August 2013. There are currently 29 passengers certified for the program.
