## **Lift Service Fare – one way trip**

Cash (within $\frac{3}{4}$ mile service area)	\$ 4.00
10-Ride Ticket Strip	\$ 40.00
Premium (outside service area but within city limits)	\$ 15.00

## **MOD Service – one way trip**

Credit/Debit (only thru MOD App)	\$ 2.00
