** Riding at a reduced fare requires the appropriate Topeka Metro reduced fare ID. Reduced fare applications can be obtained at Quincy Street Station (820 SE Quincy) or at topekametro.org. Income reduced fare applications are also available through local social service agencies and must be authorized by an agency prior to obtaining a reduced fare ID or riding at a reduced rate. Agencies may purchase 24-Hour Passes online or at QSS in bulk (quantities of 100) at a discounted rate.*
